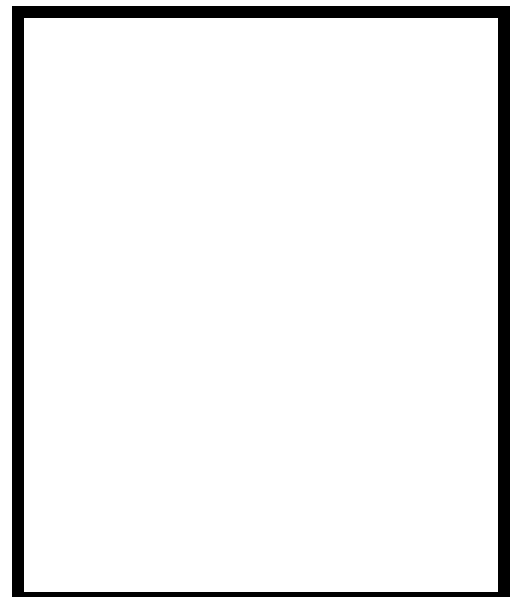
SPACE

objects.

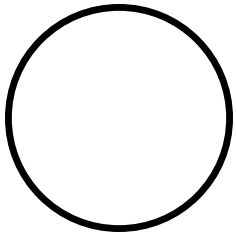

LINE



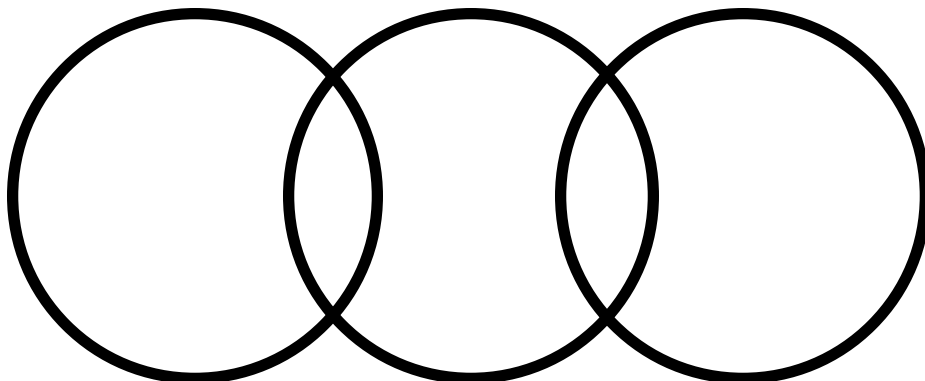
A line is a moving dot.

COLOR

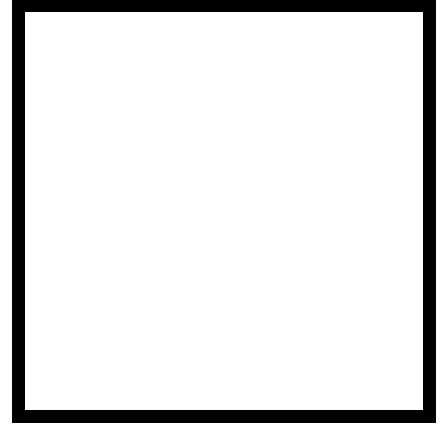
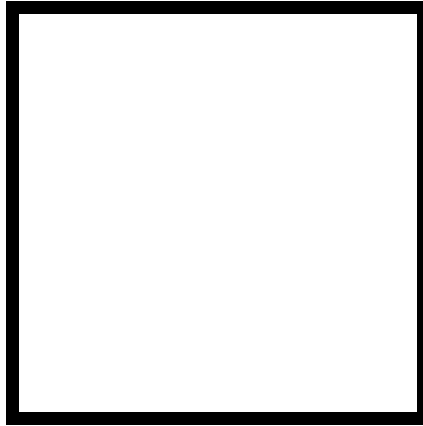
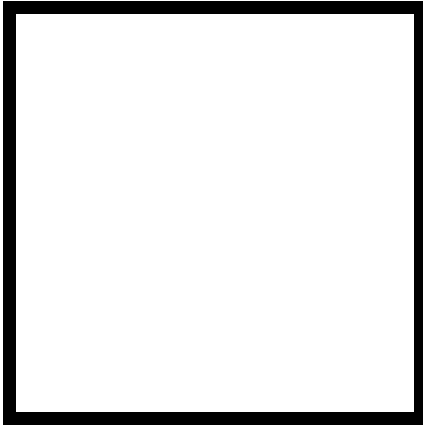
The three primary colors are

LIGHT

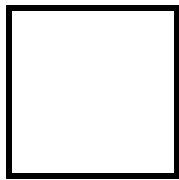

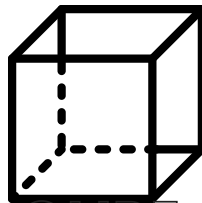


FORM

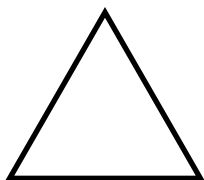
Forms are three dimensional shapes.



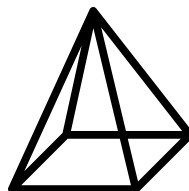
SQUARE
